Mr. Bell,

To answer your question, the sworn officers with the Utah Bureau of Criminal Identification (BCI) taught the Utah Department of Natural Resources (DNR State Park Officers & upper management with the Division of Wildlife Resources) a two hour concealed firearm permit and weapon law update/refresher class in 2009.

You are correct in reference to the types of firearms a Utah concealed firearm permit allows you to carry fully loaded and concealed. As long as the firearm the permit holder intends on carrying is legal to own and possess per state and federal law, a valid Utah concealed firearm permit holder can legally possess/carry rifles, shotguns and/or handguns.

I hope this helps answer your question.
