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The undersigned Paul Nielson - SALT LAKE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE, Agency Case No. 09-68064, upon a written affidavit states on information and belief that the defendant, REGINALD GEORGE CAMPOS, committed the crime of:

COUNT 1

ATTEMPTED MURDER WITH INJURY, (2129) 76-5-203(2)(a) UCA, first degree felony, as follows: That on or about July 22, 2009 at 15200 South Iron Horse Blvd, in Salt Lake County, State of Utah the defendant intentionally or knowingly attempted to cause the death of another and the victim or another suffered serious bodily injury.

COUNT 2

AGGRAVATED ASSAULT, (137) 76-5-103 UCA, third degree felony, as follows: That on or about July 22, 2009 at 1570 West Iron Horse Blvd, in Salt Lake County, State of Utah the defendant did commit assault as defined in Utah Code 76-5-102 and used a dangerous weapon or other means or force likely to produce death or serious bodily injury.

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COUNT 3

AGGRAVATED ASSAULT, (137) 76-5-103 UCA, third degree felony, as follows: That on or about July 22, 2009 at 1570 West Iron Horse Blvd, in Salt Lake County, State of Utah the defendant did commit assault as defined in Utah Code 76-5-102 and used a dangerous weapon or other means or force likely to produce death or serious bodily injury.

AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE:

Your Affiant bases this Information upon the following:

The statement of David Serbeck that on July 22, 2009, while driving in his neighborhood near 1570 West Iron Horse Blvd, Salt Lake County, an SUV vehicle pulled in front of him and slammed on its brakes, forcing him to stop. The driver of the SUV, identified as defendant REGINALD GEORGE CAMPOS, exited the SUV with a gun and began pointing it at Serbeck and his passenger, Troy Peterson. CAMPOS gave orders to Serbeck to "put his hands up." Serbeck exited his vehicle with his own firearm, holding it upside down, by the barrel. He then placed the gun on the ground and kicked it away, disarming himself. The defendant then fired two shots at Serbeck. One bullet entered Serbeck's shoulder and exited through his back. Serbeck is now permanently paralyzed as a result of the gunshot.

The statement of Troy Peterson, passenger in Serbeck's vehicle, that he saw the defendant exit his vehicle and immediately point a gun at them and that he did not see Serbeck point a gun at the defendant.

The statement of Detective Paul Nielson that scene documentation shows Serbeck's firearm was on the ground when officers arrived, and that it also had the safety lock on.

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The post-Miranda statement of CAMPOS that he did get out of his vehicle, point his gun at Serbeck, fire once, change positions, and then fire again.

Pursuant to Utah Code Annotated § 46-5-101 (2007) I declare under criminal penalty of the State of Utah that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my belief and knowledge.
